



# SOL LIPKIN

In May 1996, Sol Lipkin became the first person to be inducted into The National Shuffleboard Hall of Fame as a "promoter" of the game. This exciting news was announced at a special celebration for Sol's 90th birthday. Family, friends, and associates from the world of shuffleboard were on hand to honor Sol and celebrate his long and successful career in shuffleboard.

Presented annually, the "Sol Lipkin Award" is the highest award given by The Shuffleboard Federation to recognize others who have made "... a lifetime of extraordinary contributions to the advancement of the sport."

Sol has been instrumental in both the success of the American Shuffleboard Company, and the

game of shuffleboard

— his main

motivation,

always, the love

of the game.

Shuffleboard

was not very

popular before

World War II, when Sol started his career. His promotional efforts included traveling the country selling shuffleboards, running tournaments, and setting up distributorships. Sol was also actively involved in organizing and promoting tournaments nationally, as illustrated in the mid-1950's, when he organized one of the largest tournaments ever held.

Through his work with The American Shuffleboard Company, Sol was involved in league organization and support. He also promoted and contributed to the company's newspaper, which was distributed across the country. He also was instrumental in defining and writing the "American Shuffleboard Rule Book," one of the most widely referenced shuffleboard rule books.

Even though Sol is in his 90s, he is still quite active in the world of shuffleboard. One of his more recent successes was being named as Special Consultant to Dave & Buster's. In this position, Sol assists D&B with the opening of their restaurant/entertainment complexes coast-to-coast.

- 1996 Inducted into the National Shuffleboard Hall of Fame.
- 1993 Sol Lipkin Award (Plaque) presented to the individual whom has contributed to the advancement of shuffleboard as a recognized game of skill.
- 1992 Received the "Lifetime Achievement Award" from The Shuffleboard Federation.
- 1987 Received the "Pioneer Award," presented by Bill Moore at the 1987 Michigan Open.
